

When I moved to the Department of Paediatrics in Heidelberg in 1982, gaining new knowledge through paediatric and developmental pharmacology started to become a moral imperative to prevent harm from uncontrolled drug experiments in this vulnerable population.

Today, children progressively benefit from the basic and clinical research in this field and from new regulations and guidelines.

During this symposium, organised by Antje Neubert and Matthias Schwab, we will review our current knowledge and discuss future research ideas to further advance pharmacotherapy in children.

It is a pleasure to have the leading European experts in paediatric pharmacology here in Erlangen and I wish us an inspiring and stimulating meeting.
